PROGRAM OF EVENTS

Registration—10:00 am Driver's Meeting—3:15 pm Practice—4:00 pm

- EVENT NO. 1 QUALIFICATIONS—Two laps to be run consecutively with the faster counting as official qualifying time. The fastest twelve (12) qualifiers will transfer directly to the Feature Event (Event No. 5).
- EVENT NO. 2 QUALIFYING RACE—SEE PAGE 2 FOR DETAILS—Cars qualifying 45—60 are eligible.
- EVENT NO. 3 15 LAP QUALIFYING RACE—18 starters: Cars qualifying 13, 15, 17, 19, 21, 23, 25, 27, 29, 31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41 and 43 start straight up according to official qualifying times. Cars finishing 1 & 3 in Event No. 2 will start behind qualified cars. Cars finishing 1—6 transfer to Event No. 5 and will start on the inside rows of the Feature Event (Event No. 5) according to their finishing position.
- EVENT NO. 4 15 LAP QUALIFYING RACE—18 starters: Cars qualifying 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24, 26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42 and 44 start straight up according to official qualifying times. Cars finishing 2 & 4 in Event No. 2 will start behind qualified cars. Cars finishing 1—6 transfer to Event No. 5 and will start on the outside rows of the Feature Event (Event No. 5) according to their finishing position.
- EVENT NO. 5 50-LAP FEATURE—24 starters: Top twelve (12) qualifiers start straight up according to official qualification times, with the exception that the fastest six (6) cars shall be inverted. Cars finishing 1—6 in Event No. 3 will start on the inside rows according to their finishing positions in Event No. 3, Cars finishing 1—6 in Event No. 4 will start on the outside rows according to their finishing positions in Event No. 4.

QUALIFYING RACE

When the total number of cars qualified is 37 or more, a Qualifying Race may be held for cars qualifying 33 and higher, starting straight up by qualification order. Cars finishing 1 through 4 will start behind qualified cars in the heats. Added Heat Race starters from the "Qualifying Race" are eligible for the Semi Feature and will line up according to the official qualification time.

When the total number of qualified cars is 24 or less, only 3 heats will be conducted. Cars transferring to the feature in accordance with the Official Entry Blank will line up as specified. Any additional starters may be added to the rear of the field in order of semi-feature finish. Cars transferring to the feature event will not receive posted prize money for the semi-feature.

PIT CREDENTIALS

Members agree to pay \$25.00 per entrant, \$25.00 per driver and \$25.00 per each crew member.

Non-Members will pay \$35.00

Provisional Starters

The provisional starter program will be in effect for this event. TWO (2) will be awarded to National Series Entrants who were in the Top 20 in the 2008 season entrant point standings, if eligible.

FOR PAVEMENT EVENTS ONLY

Specified Hoosier tires are required on all four wheels. 12" MG 7.3 will be the spec right rear tire.

Cars must start the feature on the same right rear tire used for qualification. If the right rear tire must be changed, the replacement tire must be the same size and compound as used to qualify and the car must start at the rear of the starting field. A different right rear may be used for the heat and semi-feature providing it is the same size and compound as the qualifying tire.

LF—MG-5, MG-6
LR—MG-5, MG-6

RF—MG-7, MG-8
RR—MG-7.3

Minimum weight is 900 pounds less driver. Any ballast used must be attached and placed in accordance with the USAC Official Competition Rules.

- All Non-Member Owners & Drivers must fill out a Temporary Permit (TP) before practice begins to receive prize money check.
- Each car is only allowed to have one transponder and it must be mounted on the right rear corner of the car.
- Tires & Fuel will be for sale at the track.
- Quiet mufflers are mandatory.
- One way radios are mandatory. (USAC will have one way radio units for sale at the track).
- The USAC one way radio frequency is **464.5500**.
